1.	Our good works must be actual from God- "They must be such as are required in the law of God and are performed in obedience to His holy will, expressed in the precepts of His law."

2.	Our good works must be built upon the right foundation- One must understand and believe the gospel first before the works that they do can be considered "good" in the sight of God. ( must be right)
