Thomas Boston's book "The Art of Man-Fishing" was written in 1699 when he was only 22 years old. However, it was not published until decades after his death. Since its publication it has "been constantly hailed by evangelicals as a masterpiece on ministry."

This book can help us think through some aspects of evangelism

While Boston clearly sees the task of evangelism as belonging primarily to ministers by the call of God upon them to a specific office of preaching the gospel, the things that he mentions can be helpful to think about for all saints as they share Christ with others

Acknowledge thine own weakness and uselessness without it, and so cry incessantly for it, that the Lord may drive the fish into the net, when thou art spreading it out." Do not be ______ of your abilities or gifts because those alone will save no one. Do not be by your lack of abilities or gifts because it is the Lord who saves. It is the Lord who blesses and in His providence He sometimes chooses to bless those of inferior gifting more than those of more advanced gifting. "Yea, has thou not observed how God owned a man very weak in gifts and made him more successful than others that were far beyond him in parts?" in fishing-You don't often catch fish immediately Salvation often takes _____ Fish are not all easily caught. Some fish are very ______-they may swim up to the net, touch it, then quick swim away. So too, some people are not "won" the first casting out of the gospel, but they may retreat back away from it after initial contact with it. "As fish sometimes come near and touch the net, and yet draw back; so many souls are somewhat affected at the hearing of the gospel, and yet remain in the fall of bitterness and bond of iniquity."
